

The Nuneaton Academy Catch Up Premium

The Nuneaton Academy receives a 'catch up' premium for pupils who have not reached the expected level in Literacy and/or Maths upon joining the Academy in Year 7. This funding is utilised to pay for these pupils who are identified through rigorous testing to have small group tuition with a Progress Coach who is trained in Direct Instruction, so that they catch up with their peers quickly.
