Please take your time to review the uniform expectations as set out below. The key areas that I would like you take particular notice of are as follows:

Blazers

The Academy blazer must be worn at all times when moving around the Academy. Pupils are allowed to remove blazers once in lessons.

<u>Jumpers</u>

A TNA branded jumper or plain black jumper (V neck or Round Neck) may be worn underneath the blazer. We do not allow 'hoodies' or other sweatshirts to be worn on site at any time. All non-uniform jumpers must be handed into the school office will not be allowed onto the school site.

Trousers

School style black trousers must be worn. No wide, flared trousers, 'skinny' jean-style black trousers or leggings.

Skirts

Skirts must be pleated and an appropriate length for a school environment. Pencil style skirts are not acceptable.

Footwear

Footwear must be plain black only.

Coats

Tracksuit tops, hoodies, zip through hoodies/jackets are not to be worn at any time to the academy.

Mobile Phones

We strongly recommend that pupils do not bring mobile phones to the academy. If parents/pupils feel that it is necessary to bring a mobile phone to school for safety reasons on the way to and from school, this must be switched off at all times within the academy and kept in pupils bags at all times. Pupils must not use mobile phones or headphones whilst on the academy site. If a pupil's mobile phone/headphones/earphones are seen. They will be confiscated irrespective of whether they are using them or not.

The principal's decision on uniform is final.
