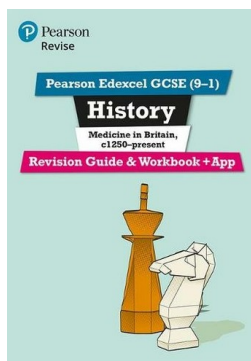
The following websites are good for independent History revision covering the Edexcel GCSE History specification.

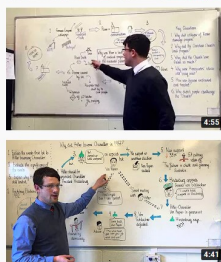
Revision Guides
