## What's going on in class:

The SEND Department have seen some incredible teaching and learning taking place throughout the week for pupils with SEND.

Most notably, pupils in Food Preparation have been cooking up a storm - from making their own lasagna sheets to fruit crumble. Teachers in these subjects have modelled to all pupils how to be safe and successful in the kitchen. Teacher demonstrations are really important in these lessons, and support pupils with SEND by showing them exactly how a task or activity should be completed.

## Additional information:

Key words -

Modelling/modelled: this is where teachers will model to pupils how to complete a task or activity so that they are successful in their learning.

Chunking: this is where teachers will chunk big pieces of information or tasks into manageable activities for all pupils, but especially those with SEND.

Scaffolding: this is where teacher provide scaffolds to help pupils with their learning e.g. sentence starters.
